- 6. Final Submission After completing the PTO tasks, *return to Skyward Family Access* and complete Steps 8 and 9.

ERIN'S LAW

House Bill 6193, known as Erin's Law, was passed in 2013. This law requires public schools to implement an age appropriate sexual abuse awareness and prevention curriculum for all students in grades pre-K-12. Mrs. Voss, Social Worker. will be delivering classroom presentations over the next couple of weeks using the "Think First and Stay Safe" program, which teaches students the importance of treating themselves and one another with kindness and respect. They learn how to set personal boundaries, recognize appropriate vs. inappropriate behaviors and make safe and healthy choices.

The program provides a balanced perspective, while keeping students engaged in learning vital safety strategies. Students are continually reassured that most people are good and kind and can be counted upon for help when the need arises. They learn to identify trusted adults in their lives and are encouraged to reach out to them when needed. STRANGER DANGER REMINDERS

Spring is just around the corner, and we'd like you to review the following ideas with your children:

- Always walk with a friend or group of friends;

- Try to remember important details about the stranger to tell to the adult;
- Make sure your parents report the incident to the police and the school office.

Children should use the sidewalks coming to and from school instead of cutting through neighbors' yards. Spring is here and everyone wants grass to grow.

DRY CLOTHES

Students get wet while playing outside and want to change into dry clothes. Please send a set of clothes for your child to keep at school, including: top, pants, underwear and socks.

DRESS CODE

With warmer weather around the corner, we need to remind students to dress appropriately for school. This includes tops that do not show the midriff and no spaghetti straps or haltertops. Please keep shorts at an appropriate length for school. Keep safety in mind when buying shoes for the spring/summer. Children will be playing outside and need to be able to run and play without twisting an ankle (avoid slides, stacked heels) or stubbing their toes (avoid skimpy sandals). They should wear socks with their gym shoes to avoid getting blisters with bare feet. Please remind children that hats/scarves should be removed when inside the school.



 The playground will be closed June 3-August 9 for installation of the new playground.






Students will be able to shop and purchase books during their weekly library time slot.
